As we approach one month of operations, we are at an important juncture to continue our work. We need to raise \$7,500 toward our annual fund goal of \$25,000 from individual contributions to continue start-up activity through the month of June. Our filing with the IRS for 501c determination is pending and we expect to receive a favorable determination during calendar year 2018. As we communicate the pending IRS determination, it will become easier and more comfortable for some to make a charitable donation, and we will apply for targeted foundation and government funding that require the designation.
